Your love and dedication are evident in every facet of our mission. Because of your contributions hundreds have turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God; Our preaching brethren are bold in our God to speak the gospel of God despite the challenges they face; Hundreds of Children are taken care of their food, shelter, health and education; widows are happily leading their life and young widows are equipped and become self-supported; Many church Buildings and Baptism tanks were built; numerous of P.A. Systems and Bicycles were provided; Hundreds of Bibles are procured and distributed along with song Books printing at Willette Graphics; hundreds of people irrespective of religion are provided medicine through the christian hospital at Rampachodavaram and many more acts of Kindness witness in India. We Thank you for your zeal for good works. "And our God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus, Now to our God and Father be glory forever and ever. Amen." We greet every saint in Christ Jesus.

GOSPEL MEETINGS and BIBLE CLASSES CONTINUED: This month too we continued to conduct Gospel Meetings and Bible Classes especially in Vizianagaram and Srikakulam which



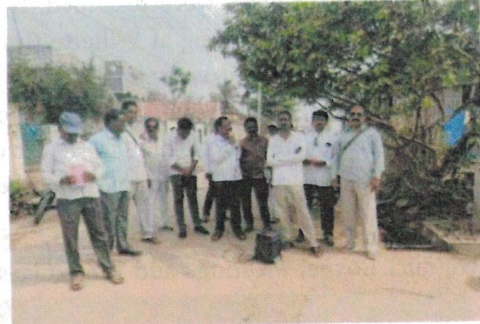
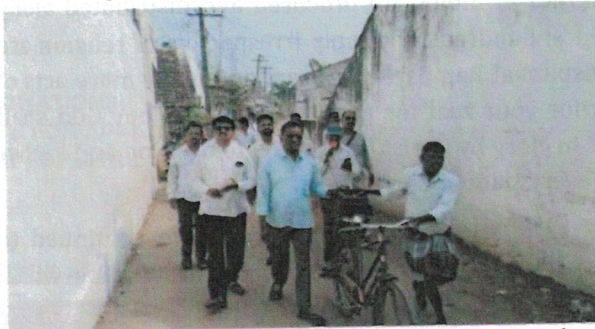
are northeast districts of Andhra Pradesh. We visited 15 places in these districts and also conducted preacher's bible class. We are so happy to report that Ratnam son of John Ratnam visited 10 places in another area called Yelamanchili along with Bro. Satish. They visited new places and met denominational preachers and studied with them. He was so glad to study with

them and reported that they are so close and open to continue to study. This is his first trip going individually and studies Bible with denominational preachers. Please continue to pray for



him. We visited some villages along with Bro. Krupakar in Narsipatnam area too near Tuni and conducted Bible Classes. On the other hand, Bro. Solomon and Bro. John Babu preached in the streets at various locations and our preachers too have conducted house meetings and studied Bible with several people. As a result, we are so glad to report 97 baptisms this month. Please continue to pray for the new converts added to the Church.

PREACHING IN THE STREETS ON THE BICYCLES: The brethren in Vizianagaram frequently engage in street preaching throughout their villages, utilizing bicycles provided by us and mobile speakers. They travel by bicycle, stopping at key junctions to share the Gospel and



distribute tracts and New Testaments that we have supplied knocking every door. This time, they repeated this effort, inviting villagers to Bible classes prior to our visit. We deeply appreciate their commitment to spreading the Word.

This year, the summer has been particularly harsh, with temperatures reaching up to 40° C (104° F); nevertheless, our brethren have remained dedicated to their street evangelism efforts. As a result, we have experienced a successful campaign in these regions. We would like to bring to your attention the pressing needs of these brethren, such as the construction of church buildings, baptism tanks, and assistance with repairs to their existing buildings. We were unable to visit these areas during the visit of our brethren from the U.S.A. due to previous resistance. However, these regions border Odisha, where we have successfully built two church buildings in Telugu-speaking villages. Please keep us in your prayers as we continue our efforts to expand the reach of His kingdom.

HOLY BIBLES and SONG BOOKS: We are pleased to announce that we have received another order for 1,000 copies of Holy Bibles. We greatly appreciate your ongoing support for the purchase of these Bibles. Additionally, our order for another 10,000 copies of Bibles is still pending with the Bible Society of India.

(Contd..2..) Along with the Bibles, we also distribute songbooks. We kindly ask for your prayers as we aim to print an additional 10,000 copies of songbooks for distribution in the churches. Despite having printed thousands of copies, there remains a significant need for songbooks within the congregations. Villagers are eager to receive their own copies of both the songbook and the Holy Bible, and they wish to attend church gatherings with both in hand. Please pray that every Christian may have their own copy of a songbook and a Holy Bible.

CHURCH BUILDINGS: Dear Brethren, we wish to express our heartfelt gratitude for your assistance in constructing church buildings in various remote villages. We are particularly



thankful to the elders at Willette Church of Christ for their support of numerous structures in these underserved areas of Andhra Pradesh and her border states. Despite your generous contributions, the need for additional buildings remains a pressing need. We kindly ask that you keep this need in your thoughts and prayers and consider how you can continue to help us. It is important to note that anti-Christian groups have a hidden agenda to introduce anti-conversion bills and prevent the construction or maintenance of church buildings in these villages. If possible, they are even attempting to dismantle existing structures under the pretext that they were not built according to guidelines, causing chaos and threatening to bring these edifices down. Such incidents are occurring frequently in and around us. Before these challenges escalate further, we aim to support the construction of as many buildings as we can. We sincerely request your prayers for this urgent need. Thank you for standing with us in this vital mission.

PRAYER REQUESTS: There are several preachers need your prayers for their health issues. Bro. Yeddu Satyam has been working with us for almost 30 years and he is in his old age and bedridden. Brother Lazarus is preaching in his place now. We



are still supporting Bro. Satyam and sending his help to his house and giving his wife. Bro. Anantha Rao who is working in Geddada had heart stroke and sent to Hospital at Rajahmundry. He is now



recovering. Two preachers died this month and we are sending preacher from nearby village in their place. Looking to send someone who is willing to go. Please pray. Bro. Mukkayya underwent heart surgery and needs your prayers. We want to train more preachers as many of preachers who have long standing of preaching have become old. We are making sure that no congregation is left without preacher and we are sending on temporary basis and looking for permanent preachers. Please pray.

SUPPORT FOR FIRE VICTIMS: We thank you for your financial support to the fire victims requested in March Newsletter. We are going to visit the village in the last week of this month. All pictures of distribution will be presented in the next month newsletter. We thank you for your kind heart.
