Greetings in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We thank you for your steadfast support in expanding the borders of Christ's kingdom here in the remote parts of Andhra Pradesh and neighbouring states in India. Your involvement, whether through prayers or financial contributions, enables us to spread the gospel to numerous new villages in the remote areas of our tribal districts. The uniqueness of our mission lies in its focus on the tribal regions, where we strive to empower preachers to reach every village, including the more isolated areas with very few inhabitants. One such village is Ijjaluru, which is home to just 11 residents and is accessible only by foot, requiring us to cross two hills.

CHILDREN HOME AT RAMPACHODAVARAM: Schools were reopened after summer vacation and our children at Rampachodavaram are so happy to go back to school wearing new school

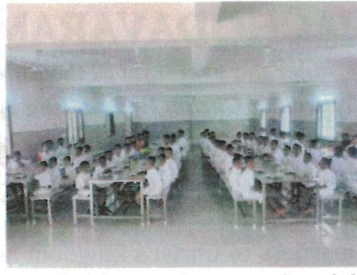
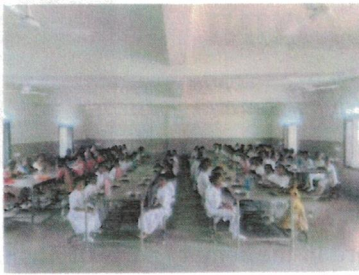


uniforms, notebooks, textbooks, school bags, shoes etc., Sister Indira took personal care to see all clothes fits well to each child and this year we admitted new children from some villages where



they speak their local dialect. They are from interior villages in Lambasingi area. When our preachers brought them to the home, they did not have any clothes. Sister Indira promptly provided them with essential clothing and necessities. Thank you for your kind support to these children. Because of your contributions, they are thriving both mentally and physically, as well as receiving training and guidance in the ways of the Lord. Remarkably, 95% of these children come to the knowledge of truth and become Christians. Our children's home accommodates children ranging from kindergarten through graduation level. The above pictures show only school level children.

We also extend our heartfelt gratitude for your generosity in providing a proper dining space and essential furniture for the children. Currently, 100 children can dine together at one time comfortably. To accommodate even more, we have purchased 25 additional tables and ordered more, aiming to ensure that at least 200 children can sit and enjoy their meals together. In addition, we have placed orders for new cooking utensils, which are expected to arrive by the end of this month, further enhancing our culinary capabilities. We have also equipped each child with plates and glasses, ensuring they dine with dignity and proper resources. Thank you for



your compassionate support. These children, who once faced food scarcity and lacked adequate facilities, now enjoy good clothing, safe shelter, and nutritious meals. Your kindness is making a significant difference in their lives, transforming their circumstances for the better.

GOSPEL MEETINGS: We conducted Gospel Meetings at various locations this month too. One



such meeting is at Guntur where Brother Dev Paul works. People from surrounding places are also invited to this meeting conducted at Ramireddy Thota Church of Christ, Guntur. We intend to conduct preachers meeting too after the



gospel meeting. Upon our arrival, we found several preachers and women from the local congregation already present, waiting for the others to join. Amidst this gathering, Brother John proposed that Sister Indira conduct a ladies' class in the church building, while he addressed the preachers who had already assembled. This decision was made spontaneously, and Sister Indira graciously agreed.

As a result, that day was bustling with activity as we conducted a ladies' class, a Preachers' class, and the Gospel Meeting. We commenced our activities at 10 AM, with the Gospel Meeting officially starting at 11:30 AM and concluding at 1:30 PM. The attendance was impressive, with over 300 participants eager to hear the message of truth, despite the midday heat under the tent. The local congregation arranged food after the meeting and bro. John Ratnam covered the cost of food. In the evening, we conducted a meeting in the nearby village. This is new area we are encouraging as mentioned in our previous newsletters. We intend to conduct Gospel Meeting in a Hall when our brethren visit India in November. We ask that you keep this initiative in your prayers.



Another preacher's meeting was held at Santhi Asram area where brother Satish has been working for many years. They also invited denominational preachers in that area. Bro. John



Ratnam preached to the denominational preachers attended there and they asked questions for which bro. John answered. Some of them agreed to attend our preacher's meeting at Kattamuru to learn more while others said they will invite some other time to hear more. This happens many times when we preach to



the denominational preachers. Sometimes, they take back step even though they convinced with the truth. They need to sacrifice to embrace truth.

On the same day, we distributed a portable P.A. System to one of our preachers after the meeting, Bro. Satish arranged food after the meeting to all the preachers gathered.

NIGHT MEETING AT A.MALLAVARAM: Night meeting at A. Mallavaram was conducted on 28th of June. We constructed a building previously in the year 2010 opened by Bro. Tim Smith but



collapsed due to natural calamity. The church in this place is gathering in a house presently. We are supporting them with another building with concrete roof in the same place. They



have already raised columns and planning to finish by the end of this year. When bro. John Ratnam visited them to see the construction, they arranged a meeting under the tree in the open place in the same evening. Christians from the nearby congregation also presented there and we were happy to see our fellow christians there and to conduct a meeting with them.

DISTRIBUTION OF SONGBOOKS: We wish to bring another update on our recent activities. Bro.



Paul Raju is working in Govalanka village which is a coastal village near Yanam. Bro. Paul Raju has been working in this village for 10 years. He gave space upon his house to construct a place of worship. We opened this building on 29th and preached. We also distributed songbooks to all. Thanks to your generous support in printing these songbooks, we are now able to share spiritual songs across multiple congregations during our visits.

DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY BIBLES: We distributed Holy Bibles also to the preachers who attended the meeting with good report of new converts. We provided Bibles based on the



number of baptisms that were performed during the month. My son, B. Ratnam, handed over these out to the preachers. Brother Joseph led the way with a remarkable 25



baptisms this month, continuing his impressive record. Thank you, dear brethren, for your generous and sacrificial support.

Brother Satyam has passed away after being bedridden for a long time, and our brethren held his funeral. He leaves behind his wife and two children. Since he had been unable to preach for nearly six months, we are sending another preacher to lead the congregation. Brother John Ratnam provided 25,000 rupees to assist with funeral expenses and other household necessities. In the event of a preacher's death, we typically contribute 25,000 rupees to support the family. Brother Lazarus has taken over preaching responsibilities in Satyam's absence. Please keep his family and the congregation in your prayers.
